Spring (March until the end of April)
Mar 1 – Mar 31 from 9am to 6pm
Apr 1 – Apr 30 from 9am to 7pm

Summer/Autumn (May until mid-October)
May 1 – Aug 15 from 9am to 9pm
Aug 16 – Sep 15 from 9am to 8pm
Sep 16 – Oct 15 from 9am to 6pm

Winter (mid-October until the end of February)
Oct 16 – Feb 28 from 9am to 5pm
