# **Coronavirus: The opening strategy for Bavaria in March 2021**

# Stage 1 from 01/03/2021

Hairdressers and foot, nail and facial salons flower shops, garden centres, plant nurseries and DIY stores

### Stage 2 from 08/03/2021

Booksellers, bookstores, libraries, archives

### Stage 3 from 08/03/2021

Infection rate 0–50: Retail 1 person with restricted access

Museums, plant nurseries, zoos, botanical gardens, monuments/historical sites

Non-contact sport outside: max. 10 persons or max. 20 children under 14 years of age

#### Infection rate 50–100:

"Click & Meet" at retail outlets 1 person per 40 m<sup>2</sup> with a fixed time slot

Museums, galleries, zoos, botanical gardens, monuments/historical sites only with a fixed time slot

Non-contact sport outside: max. 5 persons from max. 2 households max. 20 children under 14 years of age

# Stage 4 no earlier than 12th of April 2021

#### Infection rate 0–50:

Outside eating, theatres, concert venues and opera houses, cinemas, non-contact sport inside, contact sport outside (test not required)

#### Infection rate 50–100

with a test updated daily in each case: Outside eating with a fixed time slot Theatres, concert venues and opera houses, cinemas, non-contact sport inside, contact sport outside

# Restrictions on personal contact

Infection rate below 35: Own household + 2 households max. 10 persons

# Infection rate 35–100:

Own household + 1 household max. 5 persons

Children under 14 years of age are not counted in each case.

# With increasing incidence rates.

7-day infection rate on 3 consecutive days <50/100 or

7-day infection rate on3 consecutive days >50:Change in the new infection rate phase one day after notification

7-day infection rate on 3 consecutive days above 100: Emergency brake: The measures

in force before 8th March will again apply (including a curfew from 10.00 pm to 5.00 am, own household + 1 person).
