Welcome to Augsburg

Just under 300 000 people live in Augsburg. This makes Augsburg the third largest city in Bavaria. The inhabitants are distributed in a total of 42 city districts, from Haunstetten-Süd to Firnhaberau, from Bergheim to Lechhausen-Ost.

The city of Augsburg is rich in tradition and culture. With its more than 2 000 years of history, it has much to offer: from the Romans to the textile industry. The town hall, the Golden Hall and the Maximilian Museum tell Augsburg's story – together with many other sights and museums.

Cycle through the Siebentischwald, shop in Annastraße, have a coffee at the city market and then join in the excitement in the WWK Arena or maybe rather in the zoo? Enjoying leisure time is possible in Augsburg out in the open green, in the city and in the stadium.





Bus and Tram

Augsburg has a large network of tram and bus lines. Many places are also easily accessible on foot.

What do fo, if a child is in danger?

Children have the right to a happy childhood and to grow up free of violence.

Corporal or psychological punishments are not a suitable means for the education of children and are therefore prohibited in Germany.

Feeling overwhelmed with raising children? If so, you can get help from the social services. There are specialists there who can help you to better cope with everyday life with a child.

Are you concerned about a child in danger? Please contact the social services in this case as well. Children and adolescents can also make a report themselves if they are experiencing violence or neglect at home.
